Next season will be very challenging for everyone as the club will be fielding a sixth team. So lets all get on the recruiting campaign now!!

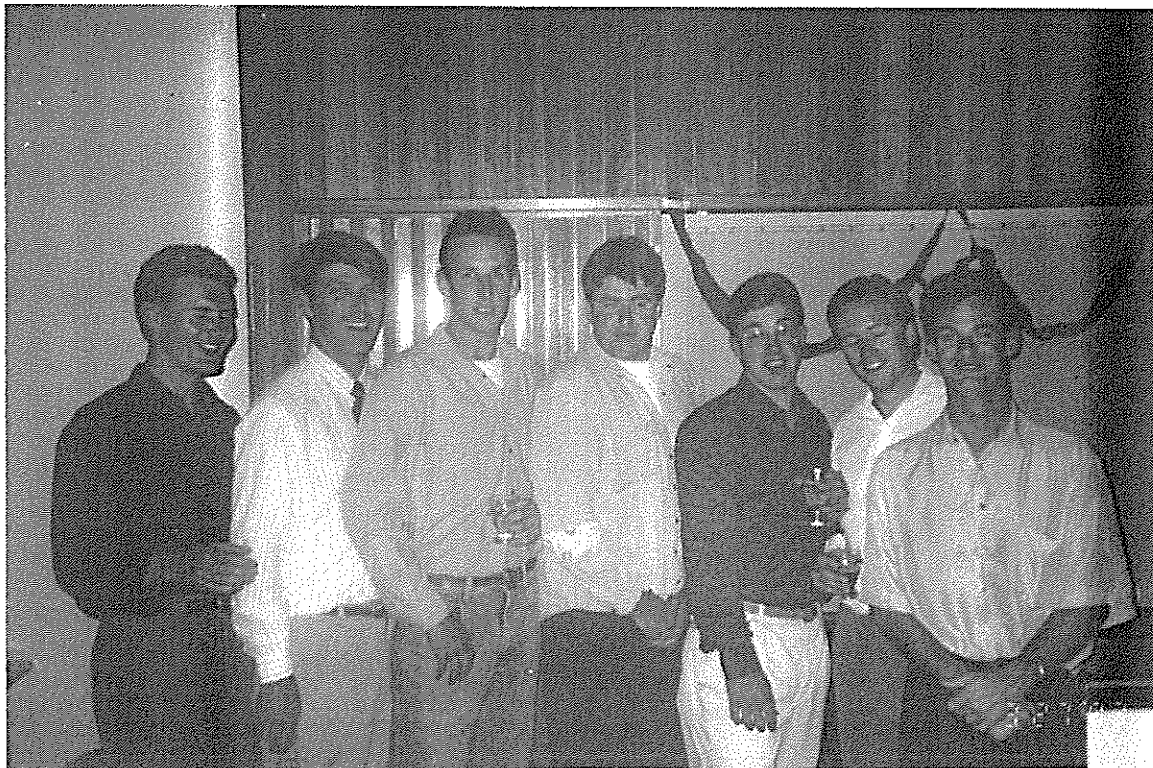
The club will be holding a cricket conference later in the year for all people involved with the club to plan for next season and instil a one, five and 10 year plan. It's time for everyone to get dinkum.

COACHES REPORT

I take this opportunity to thank the committee of the Applecross Cricket Club for giving me the chance to be the coach of the club for the 1992/93 season.

The season offered plenty of challenges from the start, with the biggest, being competitive throughout the grades and earning promotion for the 1st grade side.

For the first time the club fielded five grades and it was very pleasing for three grades to reach the finals. As was the objective, the 1st grade played very consistently throughout the season to finish undefeated, (except for a hiccup against our second side) and earn promotion to A Grade for 1993/94.

Our second and third grades also had very good seasons. The challenge is there for both sides to go one better next season.

The fourth and fifth sides certainly contributed to the depth of the club and although not having much success individually were a big help to the overall strength of the club.

A point of warning needs to be made to us all in that if we want to be more successful we all need to work a bit harder and improve a bit more. There is no reason why we all cannot improve overall and be a bit better and stronger mentally - particularly when it counts in big games such as finals.

I thank all the players for their efforts and support over what was a long season starting in early August and going to the middle of March. Everyone's effort was very consistent and a credit to all players. I also thank all the grade captains, and Dave Wells for their help at the selection table and also with Wellsy doing his scoring and team managers job.

Thanks also goes to Sally and Lorraine for their terrific work in the kitchen, Val behind the bar, Hedley at the nets and Russell and the committee overall, for without the efforts of these people the club would be no where near as strong as it is now.

In wrapping up what was I feel a very good season, I congratulate the club on its efforts for the season. I think our club can be proud of its achievements and of the fact that it is a very good "Club". It has now made a statement and it is up to all of us to make sure we back up that statement on the field. I am sure we all look forward to facing the challenge and backing it up with our performance next season.

CAPTAIN'S REPORT - 1ST ELEVEN 1992/93

I look forward eagerly to 1993/94 for many reasons, not least to get the series final game off our back but also to match it and better, which I firmly believe we can do, with the rest of the A grade sides. We need to be harder on ourselves and on our team mates, bolster our batting a little and there is no reason that we can't have another very successful season in A grade in 1993/94. The challenge is there, the balls in our court, I look forward to us accepting the challenge and "doing it again" next year.

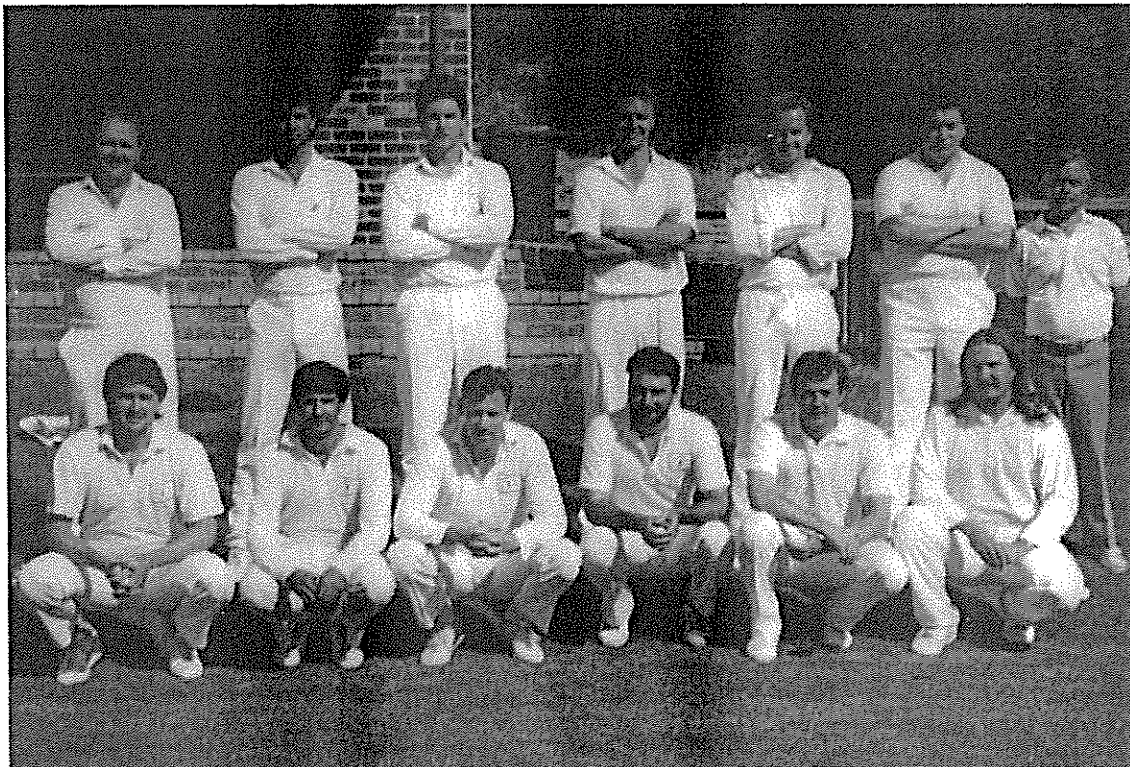

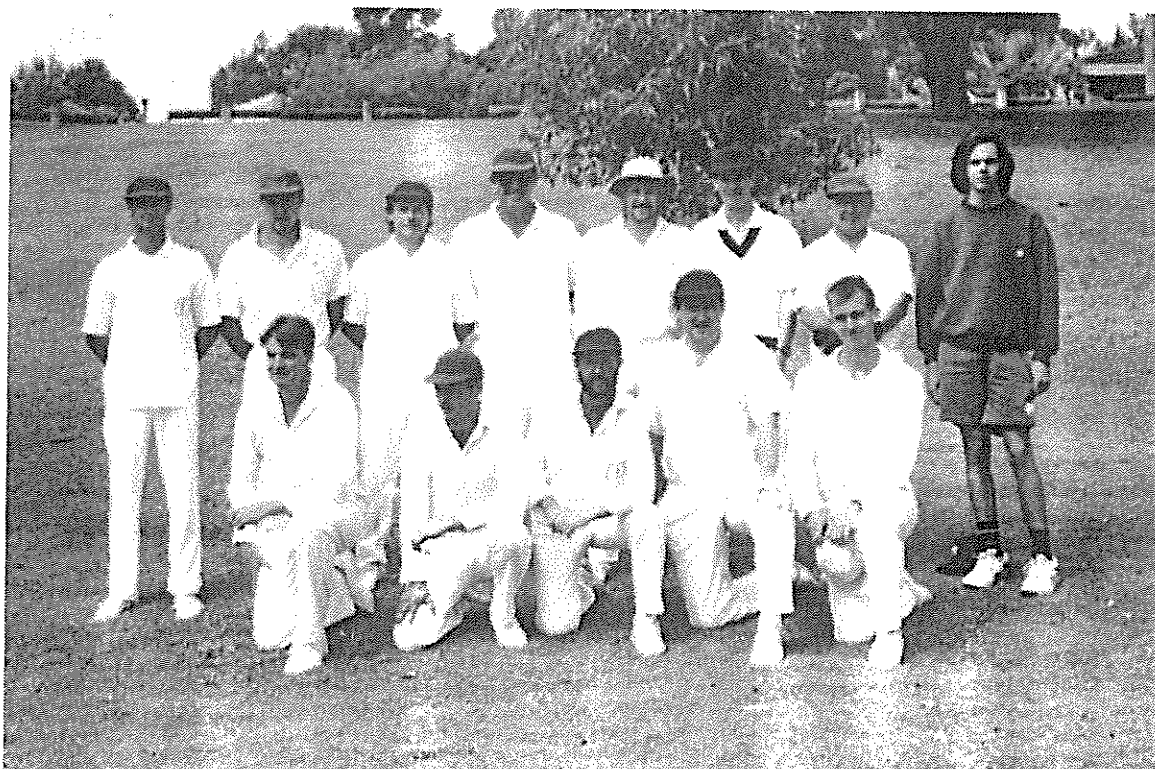
